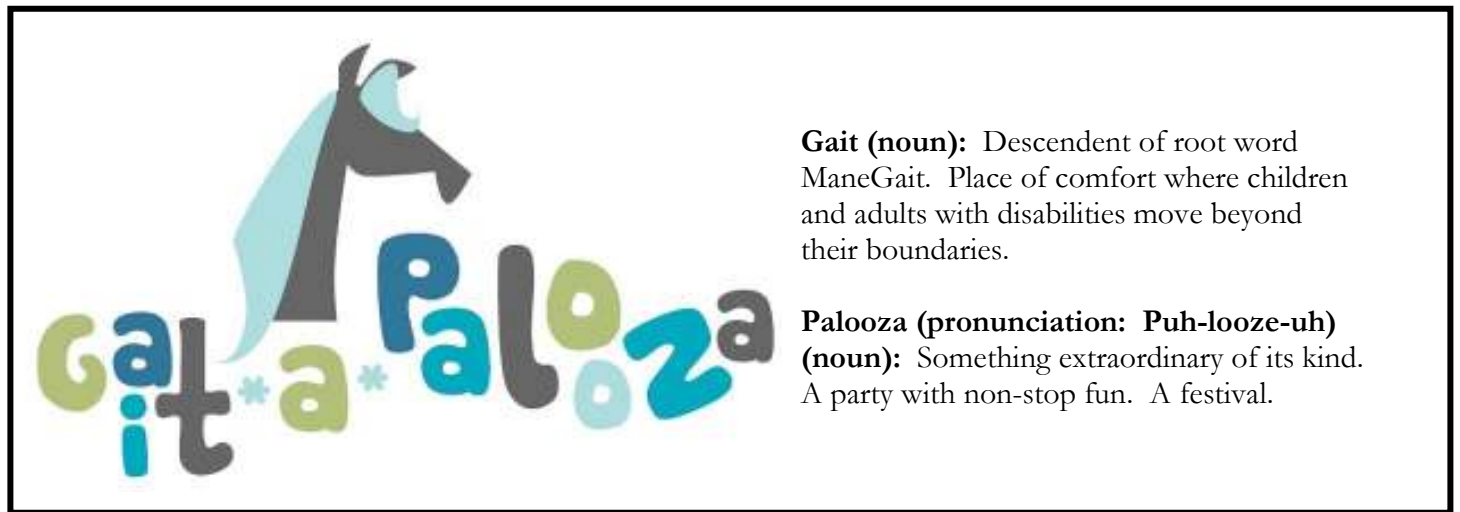


ManeGait Therapeutic Horsemanship for people with disabilities announces the first annual trail ride & family festival called...
